

MT SILVERWOOD RC CLUB FLYING FIELD RULES

1. The planes and equipment being used by club members and their guests shall be airworthy and in safe operating condition.
2. There shall be no parking on the flying field due to damage to the field.
3. NEVER turn on your transmitter without checking for other fliers with the same frequency or have the appropriate frequency clip on your antenna.
4. At all times treat other pilots with respect and courtesy.
5. Remember, the pilot in the air has the right-of-way. Always announce your intent to taxi onto the runway. If for any reason the pilot with his plane in the air ask you to wait, WAIT. If the OK to enter the runway is given, then do so. Always use caution when taking off or landing.
6. Do NOT fly over the pit area or anywhere behind the flight line. This is the east side of the runway.
7. Do not fly over houses, near the road or near the power lines.
8. Stay off the runway when planes are in the air, except for emergency plane retrieval.
9. Always park your vehicle on the spectator side of the flight line.
10. Taking off and landing should always be in the direction of South or North.
11. No alcohol at the field.
12. No flying before 9:00 AM.
13. No flying at this field unless you hold a current AMA membership.
14. After a fun day of flying clean up any garbage. Check the area for any equipment you may have missed. The last person leaving the field makes sure the frequency board is stored and the outhouse is locked.
15. Always use common sense and fly safely.
